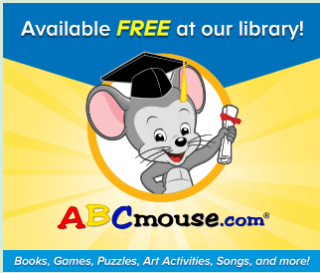

Middleborough Public Library invites you to join us and read **1,000 Books Before Kindergarten.**



Studies have shown that young children who are read to regularly can read and write their own names earlier, and count higher before children who were not. We know that reading is key to brain development, language skills, and building a vocabulary. Join our 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten program and share the joy of reading with your child.

Who is this program for?

This is for kids from birth-6 years of age and their caregivers.

How do I sign up?

You can stop by the library or sign up online by going to the library website: midlib.org.

What do I do?

Start reading to your child and keep track of the number of books you read. Mark them off on the reading log or enter them online. Have a favorite story? Log and enter every time you read it.

- Read 250 books and receive a library book bag.
- Reach 500 books and you've earned your first board book to keep.
- Reach 750 books and you've earned another book.
- Reach 1,000 books and your child will receive a backpack for Kindergarten.

.....BUT 1,000 books is a lot- how can I read that many?

3 books a day for 1 year= 1,095 books

1 book a day for 3 years= 1,095

Don't forget to count the books Miss Amanda shares at Storytime! They count too!
