do hereby certify that the following Restatement of the Articles of Organization was duly adopted at a meeting held on: (mm/dd/yyyy) 05/29/2025, by vote of: members, 8 directors, or shareholders, being at least two-thirds of its members/directors legally qualified to vote in meetings of the corporation (or, in the case of a corporation having capital stock, by the holders of at least two thirds of the capital stock having the right to vote therein).	
ARTICLE I The exact name of the corporation is: THE FRIENDS OF THE MIDDLEBORO PUBLIC LIBRARY, INC.	
ARTICLE II The purpose of the corporation is to engage in the following business activities: THE CORPORATION IS ORGANIZED EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE, EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES, INCLUDING, FOR SUCH PURPOSES, THE MAKING OF DISTRIBUTIONS TO ORGANIZATIONS THAT QUALIFY AS EXEMPT ORGANIZATIONS UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, OR THE CORRESPONDING SECTION OF ANY FUTURE FEDERAL TAX CODE.MORE SPECIFICALLY, THE CORPORATION'S PURPOSES FOCUS ON THE LITERACY AND EDUCATION COMPONENTS OF IRS NONPROFIT 501(C)(3) CLASSIFICATIONS. AMONG OTHER LAWFUL ACTIVITIES, THE CORPORATION MAY PROVIDE FUNDING FOR PROGRAMS OFFERED BY THE STAFF OF THE MIDDLEBOROUGH PUBLIC LIBRARY AND ENHANCE AND ENLIVEN THE EXPERIENCE OF LIBRARY USERS. IT MAY SPONSOR EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL PROGRAMS FOR ADULTS, TEENS, AND CHILDREN, AND MAY PARTNER WITH OTHER ORGANIZATIONS TO BENEFIT THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE. THE CORPORATION WILL ATTEMPT TO BUILD A STRONG NETWORK OF VOLUNTEERS, DONORS, AND PARTNERS WHO ASPIRE TO PROMOTE EDUCATION, COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT, AND CULTURAL PRESERVATION, THEREBY IMPACTING THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR RESIDENTS OF MI

ANY SUCH ASSET NOT DISPOSED OF SHALL BE DISPOSED BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE CORPORATION IS THEN LOCATED, EXCLUSIVELY FOR SUCH PURPOSES OR TO SUCH ORGANIZATION(S), AS SAID COURT SHALL DETERMINE, WHICH ARE ORGANIZED AND OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR SUCH PURPOSES.

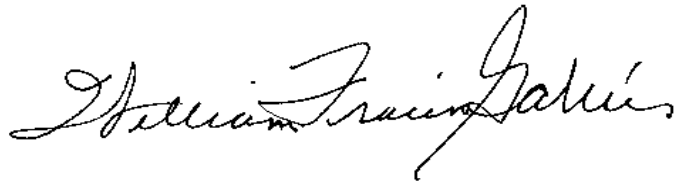
